## Covid-19 Policy

### Venue hire

- 1) All parties acknowledge the ongoing COVID-19 crisis in South Africa and globally and accept their obligation to comply with any official guidance from local government.
- 2) The parties agree to communicate without delay any issues they may have in performing their obligations under College of Magic (COM) policies and agreements.
- 3) The customer acknowledges that COVID-19 may require to take one or more of the following measures for the safety of the venue staff and the safety of guests attending the event to which this booking relates:
  - a) Impose maximum delegate numbers at the event
  - b) Limit food or drink availability
  - c) Impose specific requirements regarding personal protective equipment such as the wearing of masks
  - d) Limit any planned activities during your event
  - e) Designate alternative entrance and exit routes
  - f) In some circumstances we might consider revising your booking fee
- 4) If COM is obliged due to specific government restrictions, to close the venue, the COM may offer the client an alternative date for the event but if that cannot be agreed the booking will be deemed cancelled and the deposit will be returned in full with no further payment required.
- 5) COM monitors government guidelines continuously through this period and will update the client regularly.
